1. Where the exams are online, they must be properly typed.
2. Online students have eight (08) hours in which to write and submit their exams answer scripts.
3. Exams not submitted within the stipulated submission period will not be accepted as the system will automatically shut. (For online exams)
4. Only students who have submitted both their continuous assessments/assignments will be allowed to sit for the end of semester exams (strictly).
5. It is serious examination malpractice to be found with unauthorized materials during the exams.
6. All students with outstanding arrears are reminded to clear their semester fees before or by the date of exams registration (Monday 17<sup>th</sup> – Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2025) and be registered for the end of semester exams.
7. Students with outstanding arrears (including rentals for those in university provided accommodation) will not be eligible to take the end of semester exams. Only students who will have fully paid their semester tuition, fees and other related charges, are eligible to sit the end of semester exams.
8. Note that law students are allowed to carry copies of relevant statutes referenced during lectures in the exams. The statutes must be clean and not written on. Students found with foreign materials attached to their statutes will automatically be disqualified from the exams.
